



## The RESULT Trial

### Resveratrol and Sirolimus in LAM

The University of Cincinnati is recruiting 25 patients with LAM (lymphangiomyomatosis) who are currently taking sirolimus to participate in a research study.

The study aims to investigate the effects of adding another medication, resveratrol, to the on-going sirolimus on the disease course.

Study participants will...

- Be enrolled in the study for 24 weeks
- Complete 4 in-person visits (travel reimbursement is available)
- Complete between-visit phone calls and laboratory testing to monitor safety
- Receive study drug (resveratrol) and instructions for daily dosing
- Be given a device to perform home spirometry as part of the study

Study Visits will include...

- Medical history
- Physical examination
- Quality of life questionnaires
- Blood work (including VEGF-D levels)
- Pulmonary function tests

Visits will take place in the Schubert Research Center at Cincinnati Children's Hospital and the Pulmonary Clinic in Holmes Hospital. This study is being conducted under the supervision of Dr. Nishant Gupta. For additional information, please the study team at:

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
